- 3. Read 2 Chronicles 7:11-16
- 4. Why do you think God would prepare his people for a future where they will turn against him?
- 5. How would you define "humble themselves"? What does that look like?
- 6. Why do you think humility is such a key to prayer?
- 7. What do you think the link between humility, prayer, seeking God's face and turning from our wicked ways is?
- 8. What is God's promise in this passage? How would that have given hope to people experiencing some of what is described in vs. 13?
